

Technical Rider

This show about emigration waves takes place in an articulated lorry disguised as a removal van.

Lasting approximately 30 mm (+ 15 mm introduction outside the truck), the show can be performed 3 times a day.

Lorry size : Required

metric system ! "stage" area :

Sitting capacity in the lorry:


All audiences perf: 36 ppl max


School perf: 40 ppl max

> if older, then 36 ppl max







- .- The truck will be parked in a clear and open space, with level ground. It should be accessible to the audience but be kept away from traffic and passers-by. Ideally, the performance location should not be visible from the audience meeting place. Please take good note of this, if (future) members of the audience can see the truck, many surprises will be spoiled (including the outcome of the show).
- It is essential that the quietness of the surroundings of the venue be ensured during the shows.
- During the introduction, which will take place in a covered area out of sight of the truck, members of the audience will be distributed removing boxes. After the distribution, a remote-controlled miniature replica of the lorry will guide the spectators and their loads to the performance vehicle.

A removal man (human-size puppet) will welcome the group at the lorry tailgate and indicate to the spectators where to store their boxes. A second removal man will assist the group inside the truck. He is preparing a surprise, the show can now begin...

- Members of the audience will stay for a full half an hour inside the truck (with either air-conditioning or heat).

Requirements:

- 3 separated electrical circuits 16A 220V (minimum 2)
- 1 stage manager / stagehand
- 1 person to welcome the audience and hand out the boxes.
- 1 covered space to welcome the audience members and distribute the removal boxes.
- 1 dressing room or, at least, an access to toilets and water.
- If the crew arrives the evening before performance day, the tuck must be parked at the performance location as it cannot easily be parking in front of a theater or at a hotel...
- Provide lifts for the team between the hotel and the venue (for 3 people; if more than 15-min walk distance).
- Secure parking at night, as well as during OFF-days.

- On no account will the lorry be moved to another place for the night if performances are scheduled at the same location the next morning.

Attention:

The lorry is not suited for people with reduced mobility (wheelchairs) and should be strongly advised against for people sufffering from claustrophobia.

Mantling of the set :

- If the lorry is already parked on the exact performance location and if the electrical wiring is already in place and powered up: $1 \text{ hour before the } 1^{\text{st}}$ performance.
- If the lorry is not yet parked : $\underline{1 \text{ hour } 30 \text{ mn}}$ before the 1^{st} performance.
- After the first performance day, if the location has not changed, the team will arrive 1 hour before performing.

Dismantling :

- half an hour
